Important Instructions:

2. **Academic Performance:** Applicants must upload all the qualification-related documents (Class 10, 12, Undergraduate Degree Marks Card (Semester/Year/Consolidated), and specific document pertaining to the programme), in the link provided in application status login under the document upload tab within five (5) days of submitting the application form online. **Else your application will be rejected. *Applications with no marks cards, other mandatory documents or unclear scanned copies will be rejected and termed as Not Eligible.**
3. The date and time for the selection process are auto-generated by the system. **Therefore, any request for changes will not be entertained.**
4. You are requested to check your application status for all your **selection process details.**
5. **No EMAIL OR SMS communication** will be sent about GD_MP_WSA_VA_PI OR SA_MP_PI date and time update.
6. Candidates may prepare their travel plan as per the "Important Dates Section" and book the travel tickets well in advance in order to avoid disappointment in losing an opportunity to appear in the selection process.
7. Candidates failing to appear for the selection process at the stipulated date and time will be considered as "Not Selected".
8. It is required to have the copy of admit card and all the original marks cards and a photo identity for verification at any stage of the selection process. Failing which the application will be considered as "Not Selected".
9. It is recommended to reach the selection process (GD_MP_WSA_VA_PI OR SA_MP_PI) venue on the allotted date and at least 30 minutes prior to the time stipulated in the selection process admit card.
10. Impersonation or any suspicious behaviour (prompting by a third person or accessing notes/gadgets) will be treated as malpractice and the application will be termed as "Not Selected".
11. The responsibility of satisfying the eligibility criteria for admission rests with the student/candidate. The issue of the E-Admit Card for the selection process does not imply that the eligibility criteria are satisfied.
12. **Admit card issued 2 to 3 days** prior to the scheduled date.
